For over 15 years Rodrigo has been working towards sustainability in NGO's, universities, and corporations, engaged in R&D around organizational change, sustainability assessment and reporting, and environmental management practices. His work was shortlisted for the Times Higher Education Awards in 2008 and he is also the managing director of Organisational Sustainability Ltd. (www.org-sustainability.com).
