In its first year up to August 2017, Regeneration's achievements include:



416 items brought in for repair and 80% successfully repaired not sent to landfill



Over 500 local community visitors and 40 students actively learning how to repair



Special themed workshops on repair and reuse for IT, technology and clothing



Advice clinics on saving energy at home, composting, gardening and food waste
